June 26, 2017

The meeting started at 5:40pm, following an Executive Session meeting on personnel, legal, and contractual matters. Standing room only. All 9 Board members were present except for Board Vice-Chair Rev. Dr. Eric Mack, who participated by conference call. Dr. Postlewait, the Superintendent of Schools, was also present on the dais.

All Executive Session matters were passed by the Board. Special recognitions were given to School Resource Officers, Ms. Davis, the retiring principal of Mt. Pleasant Academy, and to the new teachers in the summer teacher residency program who will begin teaching in the CCSD in the fall.

The Superintendent's report highlighted the accomplishments of the previous school year and gave a promising forecast for the FY17 Budget.
