STILL, WE RISE: A SPIRITUALS CELEBRATION | 7:30PM

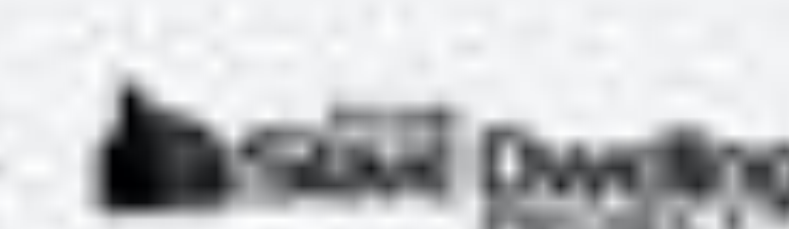
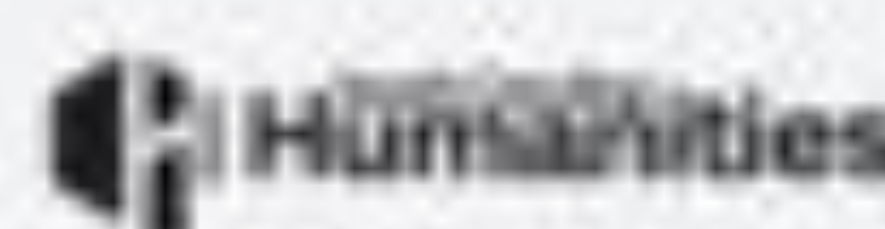
